WICO, financed as part of the Programme of Transnational Cooperation INTERREG IVC – POWER Programme is aimed at promoting the development of a low carbon economy and the reduction of greenhouse emissions. The WICO partners (Province of Ravenna (lead partner) - IT, Diputación Huelva - ES and Marine South East UK), have identified small wind systems as a possible technology which is capable of integration with other types of Renewable Energy Systems, to exploit renewable resources such as offshore and onshore coastal winds and urban airstreams. As part of the project the partners have collected data from strategically placed anemometers and pilot installations, and conducted in depth research of national policies, markets and technological frameworks, to produce Guide Lines to increase the deployment of small wind systems to generate viable renewable energy.
